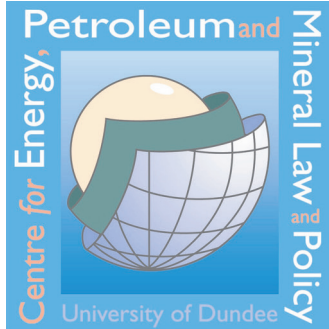

## Oil and Gas:

### *An Introduction to the Industry and the Law*

#### **Why attend:**

On day one the course will look at the **structure of the oil and gas industry** – the nature of rights held by governments; the methods of allocating rights to producing companies; the control measures used by governments; the types of company involved and the relationships between the producers and the contractor companies.

It will tell the story of what governments do through state companies, and what the government allows private investors to undertake. It will show how governments regulate the sector – health and safety; environmental regulation; conditions attached to production rights; and local content requirements. It also looks at the basic tax structures applicable in the industry.

- *The supply chain - service companies*

# No entry requirements for this introductory level programme

## Day 2

### *Why attend:*

Oil and gas law throughout the world deals with the same issues. It starts with the division of resources between states under international law. States then choose how (or whether) to transfer those rights to production companies, whether state owned or privately owned. The rights holders frequently choose to spread risk through joint ventures.

There may be a need for unitisation. Production is carried out under conditions set by government. There is a chain of contractors carrying out the work under the auspices of the operator. Production is moved to market. The commodity is sold. Tax is applied. At the end of the productive life of the field, decommissioning is necessary.

Within this broad framework, a multitude of options is open to government. Licences are different from production sharing arrangements. State company roles differ. The ability of private companies to absorb risk varies. The sensitivity to changes in law, particularly environmental conditions, varies. Starting from first principles, this course looks at the principles behind the suite of agreements underpinning an oil project.

After attending this course, delegates will be able to see **what the law does** and how it enforces the choices made by governments and companies. It will help delegates see what those options are – it is necessary to understand the policy choices which the law is enforcing.

- *Enforcement of obligations*
